## Setting Up VNC Connect Server on Your Computer

## Adding a New Connection Manually (Optional)

You will need to enter the IP address or hostname of the computer you wish to connect to, along with the VNC port number (typically 5900). You will also be prompted to enter the VNC password you set up on the VNC Server.

## Establishing Your First VNC Connection

Once both the VNC Server is configured on your computer and VNC Viewer is set up on your iOS device, you are ready to make your first remote connection. This is the moment where you'll see your desktop environment appear on your mobile screen.

## Connecting via Cloud

If you signed into VNC Viewer with your VNC Connect account, your computer should appear in a list of available devices within the app. Simply tap on the name of the computer you wish to connect to. The app will then attempt to establish a secure connection. If you have multiple computers associated with your account, ensure you select the correct one.

## Connecting via Direct IP Address

If you added a connection manually using the IP address, tap on the saved connection within the VNC Viewer app. The app will initiate the connection using the details you provided. You might be prompted to enter the VNC password again, even if you saved it during the initial setup, as a security measure.

## Navigating Your Remote Desktop

Once connected, you will see your computer's desktop displayed on your iOS device. You can interact with it using touch gestures. Tapping simulates a mouse click, swiping mimics mouse movement, and pinch-to-zoom allows you to adjust the screen magnification. You can also use two-finger scrolling to move around the desktop. The VNC Viewer app often provides on-screen controls for right-clicking, dragging, and accessing keyboard input.

# Optimizing Your VNC Connect for iOS Experience

## Troubleshooting Common VNC Connection Issues

### Connection Timed Out

If you receive a "Connection Timed Out" error, it usually indicates that the VNC Viewer cannot reach the VNC Server. This could be due to a firewall blocking the connection on either the client or server side, incorrect IP address or port configuration, or the VNC Server not running. Double-check that the VNC Server is active on your computer and that your firewall settings allow VNC traffic. If connecting over the internet, ensure your router's port forwarding is correctly configured if you are not using the cloud connection method.

## Authentication Failed

An "Authentication Failed" error means that the password you entered is incorrect. Carefully re-enter your VNC password, ensuring you're using the correct case. If you've forgotten your password, you'll need to reset it within the VNC Server application on your computer.

## Blank or Black Screen After Connecting

A blank or black screen after a successful connection can sometimes occur due to display driver issues or incorrect resolution settings. Try adjusting the color depth and resolution settings in both the VNC Server and VNC Viewer. Restarting both the VNC Server and VNC Viewer applications can also resolve this issue.

## Slow Performance and Lag

As discussed in the optimization section, slow performance is often related to network conditions or display settings. Ensure you have a strong internet connection. Try reducing the color depth, disabling visual effects, and ensuring the VNC Server is not under heavy load from other applications.
